District Rotarian of the Year Award 2010 - 2011

Each Club may nominate a **District 6220 "Rotarian of the Year"** to the District Governor. Nomination letters are due by March 15, 2011. The District Governor will recognize the recipient during the 2011 District Conference on Saturday evening, April 16, 2010.

The recipient will be determined by a District 6220 Committee comprised of: (a) Past District Governor Mary Schwaiger, (b) District Trainer David Yeghiaian, and (c) District Project Fund and Grant Subcommittee Chair Eric Paulsen.

Criteria for the nominee are:

- Must be a current member of District 6220.
- Must be in good standing and active within the Club and/or District 6220.
- Nominee must be an individual. (not a team)
- Must have demonstrated outstanding service as a Rotarian during the current Rotary year (2010 – 2011).
- In addition to the current Rotary year, nominee may have demonstrated outstanding service as a Rotarian for the past five years.
- Must have demonstrated a commitment to the "Four-Way Test" relating to truthfulness, fairness, goodwill and ethics.
- Outstanding service is defined as:
 - Reflecting exceptional leadership for a major Club or District project or multiple projects
 - Demonstrating exceptional service in a key leadership role (project leader, etc.)
 - Contributing to the community in the name of the Club or District
- Nominee must be an individual.
- The Sturgeon Bay Breakfast Rotary Club members are not eligible to receive this award.

The recipient will receive a commemorative plaque, airline tickets for two and use of a condo in Florida for one week or \$500.00.
